# **DISCLAIMER**

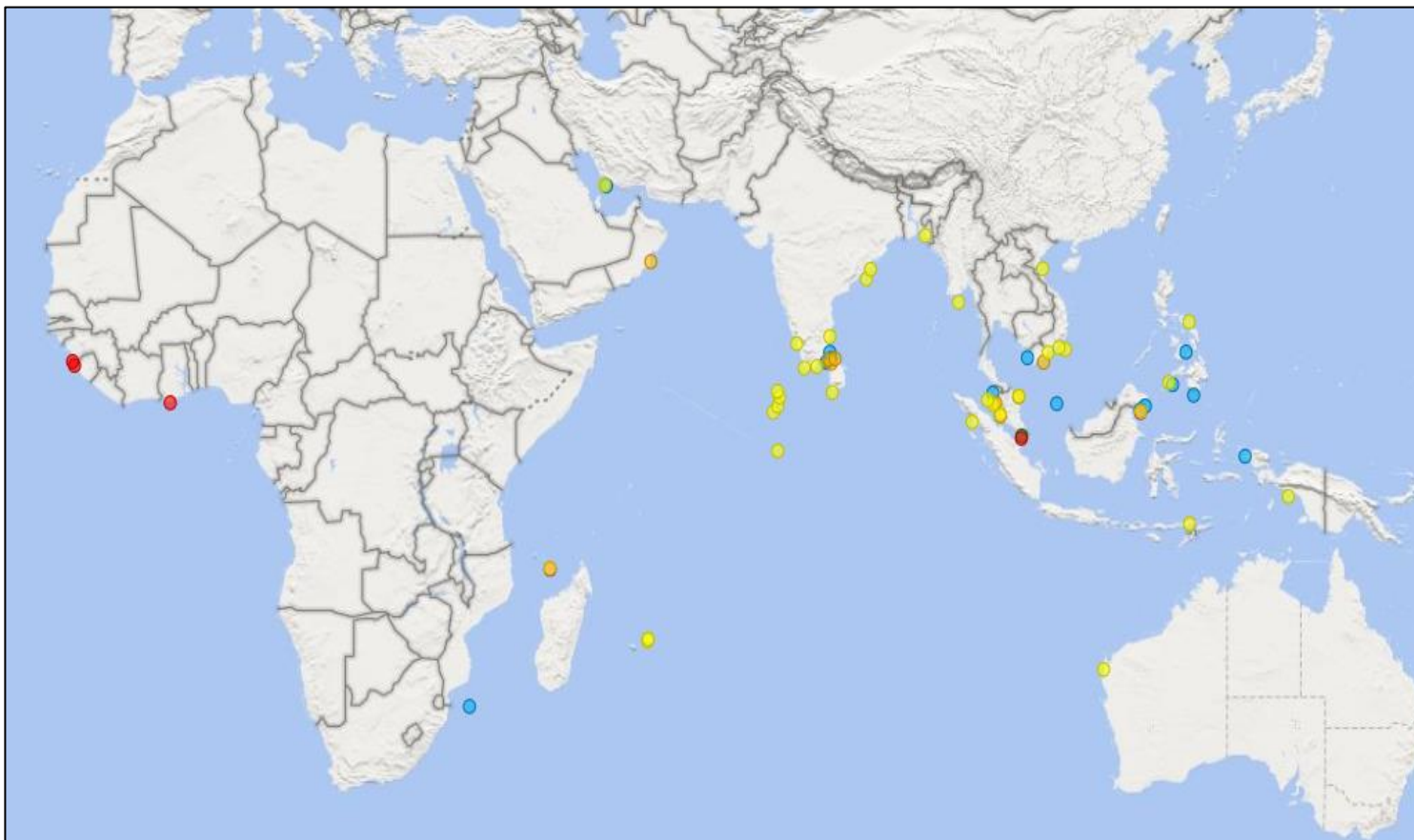
