(b) Make and Model of the batteries is not mentioned in the RFP.

<u>Clarification</u> As per extant government policy make and model can't be specified in the RFP.

(c) Is certificate from OEM to be submitted stating that the firm is their authorised channel partner or dealer?

<u>Clarification</u> Yes, submission of OEM certificate stating that the firm is their authorised dealer/channel partner is **mandatory** and the **OEM Authorisation** certificate should be submitted along with the technical bid. Failure to submit the certificate will lead to rejection of firms bid.

(d) Whether the contract is for 1 year or 3 years?

<u>Clarification</u> Initially the contract will be concluded for one year and will be extendable for further period of two years subject to satisfactory performance of the firm. However, the firm should work out its cost and submit bid as a three year contract.
