

## Part I – General information

1. **Last date and time for depositing the Bid.** 05 Jan 21 at 1430 hrs. The sealed Bid should be deposited/reach by the due date and time. The responsibility to ensure this lies with the Bidder.
2. **Manner of depositing the Bid.** Sealed bid should be either dropped in the Tender Box marked as Tender for local Procurement of consumable Medical stores including Laboratory consumable items or sent by registered post at the address given above so as to reach by the due date and time. Late tenders will not be considered. No responsibility will be taken for postal delay or non-delivery/non-receipt of bid documents. Bid sent by FAX or e-mail will not be considered (unless they have been specifically called for by these modes due to urgency).
3. **Time and date for opening of Bid.** 06 Jan 21 at 1500 hrs. (If due to any exigency, the due date for opening of the Bid is declared a closed holiday, the bid will be opened on the next working day at the same time or on any other day/time, as intimated by the Buyer).
4. **Location of the Tender Box.** INS India (Main gate), Dara Shukoh Road, New Delhi – 110011 only those bid that are found in the tender box will be opened. Bid dropped in the wrong Tender Box will be rendered invalid.
5. **Place of opening of the Bid.** Conference Room, INS India, Dara Shukoh Road, New Delhi – 110011. (The Bidder may depute their representatives, duly authorized in writing, to attend the opening of bid on the due date and time. Rates and important commercial/technical clauses quoted by all bidders will be read out in the presence of the representatives of all the bidder. This event will not be postponed due to non-presence of your representative).
6. **Forwarding of Bid.** Bid should be forwarded by bidder under their original memo / letter pad inter alia furnishing details like GSTIN number, Bank address with NEFT Account if applicable, etc and complete postal & e-mail address of their office.
7. **Clarification regarding contents of the RFP.** A prospective bidder who requires clarification regarding the contents of the bidding documents shall notify to the buyer in writing about the clarifications sought not later than 07 (seven) days prior to the date of opening of the bid. Copies of the query and clarification by the purchaser will be sent to all prospective bidders who have received the bidding documents.
8. **Modification and Withdrawal of Bid.** A bidder may modify or withdraw his bid after submission provided that the written notice of modification or withdrawal is received by the buyer prior to deadline prescribed for submission of bid. A withdrawal notice may be sent by fax but it should be followed by a signed confirmation copy to be sent by post and such signed confirmation should reach the purchaser not later than the deadline for submission of bid. No bid shall be modified after the deadline for submission of bid. No bid may be withdrawn in the interval between the deadline for submission of bid and expiration of the period of bid validity specified. Withdrawal of a bid during this period will result in Bidder's forfeiture of bid security.
9. **Clarification regarding contents of the Bid.** During evaluation and comparison of bid, the buyer may, at its discretion, ask the bidder for clarification of his bid. The request for clarification will be given in writing and no change in prices or substance of the bid will be sought, offered or permitted. No post-bid clarification on the initiative of the bidder will be entertained.

10. **Rejection of Bid.** Canvassing by the bidder in any form, unsolicited letter and post-tender correction may invoke summary rejection with forfeiture of EMD. Conditional tenders will be rejected.

11. **Unwillingness to quote.** Bidder unwilling to quote should ensure that intimation to this effect reaches before the due date and time of opening of the bid, failing which the defaulting bidder may be delisted for the given range of items as mentioned in this RFP.

12. **Validity of Bid.** The bid should remain valid till 90 days from the last date of submission of the bid.

13. **Certificate by Vendor.** It is mandatory for the vendor to fill up the compliance matrix Appendix 'A' and Fall Clause certificate at Appendix 'B' to this RFP and submit the same along with the bid submitted.

14. **Pre Bid Meeting.** The Delivery period for supply of drugs (Para 3 of part II) and Payments terms (Para 5 of para IV) should be carefully considered while preparing the bids. All clarifications are to be resolved in the pre bid conference on **04 Jan 21** at 1500 hrs at conference hall, INS India, prior submission of bids. No revision of commercial bid would normally be permitted unless the firm is called for price negotiation specifically and asked to justify the rates.

### Part III Standard Condition of RFP

Bidder is required to give confirmation of their acceptance of the standard conditions of the Request for Proposal mentioned below which will automatically be considered as part of the contract concluded with the successful Bidder (i.e. Seller in the Contract) as selected by the buyer. Failure to do so may result in rejection of the Bid submitted by the Bidder.

1. **Law.** The Contract shall be considered and made in accordance with the laws of the Republic of India. The contract shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Republic of India.

Any breach of the aforesaid undertaking by the seller or any one employed by him or acting on his behalf (whether with or without the knowledge of the seller) or the commission of any offers by the seller or anyone employed by him or acting on his behalf, as defined in Chapter IX of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1986 or any other Act enacted for the prevention of corruption shall entitle the buyer to cancel the contract and all or any other contracts with the Seller and recover from the seller the amount of any loss arising from such cancellation. A decision of the buyer or his nominee to the effect that a breach of the undertaking had been committed shall be final and binding on 175 the Seller. 5. **Agents / Agency Commission.** The seller confirms and declares to the buyer that the seller is the original manufacturer of the stores/provider of the services referred to in this contract and has not engaged any individual or firm, whether Indian or foreign whatsoever, to intercede, facilitate or in any way to recommend to the Government of India or any of its functionaries, whether officially or unofficially, to the award of the contract to the seller; nor has any amount been paid, promised or intended to be paid to any such individual or firm in respect

of any such intercession, facilitation or recommendation. The seller agrees that if it is established at any time to the satisfaction of the buyer that the present declaration is in any way incorrect or if at a later stage it is discovered by the buyer that the seller has engaged any such individual/firm, and paid or intended to pay any amount, gift, reward, fees, commission or consideration to such person, party, firm or institution, whether before or after the signing of this contract, the seller will be liable to refund that amount to the buyer. 11. **Transfer or Sub-letting.** The seller has no right to give, bargain, sell, assign or sublet or otherwise dispose of the Contract or any part thereof, as well as to give or to let a third party take benefit or advantage of the present Contract or any part thereof.

12. **Patents and other Industrial Property Rights.** The prices stated in the present contract shall be deemed to include all amounts payable for the use of patents, copyrights, registered charges, trademarks and payments for any other industrial property rights. The seller shall indemnify the buyer against all claims from a third party at any time on account of the infringement of any or all the rights mentioned in the previous paragraphs, whether such claims arise in respect of manufacture or use. The seller shall be responsible for the completion of the supplies including spares, tools, technical literature and training aggregates irrespective of the

fact of infringement of the supplies, irrespective of the fact of infringement of any or all the rights mentioned above.

13. **Amendments**. No provision of present contract shall be changed or modified in any way (including this provision) either in whole or in part except present contract. by an instrument in writing made after the date of this Contract and signed on behalf of both the parties and which expressly states to amend the present contract

14. **Taxes and Duties**

### **Part V – Evaluation Criteria & Price Bid issues**

1. **Evaluation Criteria.** The broad guidelines for evaluation of Bid will be as follows:
- (a) Only those Bid will be evaluated which are found to be fulfilling all the eligibility and qualifying requirements of the RFP,
- (b) The Lowest Bid will be decided upon the lowest price quoted by the Particular Bidders per the Price Format given at Para 2 below. The consideration of taxes and duties in evaluation process will be as follows:
- (c) The Bidders required to spell out the rates of GSTIN in unambiguous terms; otherwise their offers will be loaded with the maximum rates of duties and taxes for the purpose of comparison of prices. If reimbursement of Customs duty as per regimes GSTIN is intended as extra, over the quoted prices, the bidder must specifically say so. In the absence of any such stipulation it will be presumed that the prices quoted are firm and final and no claim on account of such duties will be entailed after the opening of tenders. If a Bidder chooses to quote a price inclusive of any duty and does not confirm inclusive of such duty so included is firm and final, he should clearly indicate the rate of such duty and quantum of excise duty included in the price. Failure to do so may result in ignoring of such offers summarily. If a bidder is exempted from payment of customs duty as per regimes GSTIN duty up to any value of supplies from them, they should clearly state that no excise duty will be charged by them up to the limit of exemption which they may have. If any concession is available in regard to rate/quantum of Customs duty as per regimes GSTIN, it should be brought out clearly. Stipulations like, excise duty was presently not applicable but the same will be charged if it becomes livable later on will not be accepted unless in such cases it is clearly stated by a Bidder that excise duty will not be charged by him even if the same becomes applicable later on. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words will prevail for calculation of price.
- (e) The Lowest Acceptable Bid will be considered further for a cement of contract / Supply Order after complete clarification and price negotiations as decided by the Buyer. The Buyer will have the right to award contracts to one Bidder only for being lowest for each category of medicines and not for whole items. 
