INDIAN NAVAL ACADEMY



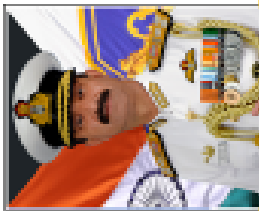
The Indian Naval Academy has been developed as a national prestigious project with a unique conceptualisation and design. It is the Cradle for Leadership in the Indian Navy. The principal role of the Indian Naval Academy is to impart basic and orientation training to all officer entrants of the Indian Navy and Indian Coast Guard. The Indian Naval Academy also plays a vital role in establishing 'Bridges of Friendship' across the oceans through training personnel from Friendly Foreign Countries.

The training is aimed at development of the trainees morally, mentally and physically so as to have the potential for assuming the highest responsibilities of leadership by imbibing in them the high ideals of loyalty, valour and patriotism. The ab-initio training imparted at the Academy ensures that every officer who passes out through its portals will be leaders worthy of trust and confidence that the nation has reposed in them.

At the INA, we believe that not only is 'change' inevitable, it is the true manifestation of growth. The INA has undergone much change over the years. In purely geographic terms, the Academy, having been set-up in Kochi in 1969, shifted in December of 1985 to an interim location at Verem, Goa before finally moving, in July of 2009, to the 2,500 acres of stunningly picturesque and verdant surrounds of its permanent abode here in Ezhimala, Kerala. However, the real change has been in functional terms, wherein the Academy now runs as many as four separate academic regimens. At the core of its training curriculum is a full-fledged, four-year 'B. Tech.' Degree Course run under the aegis of the Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi, and fully supported and supervised by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE). Having been selected by the UPSC upon successful completion of their 10+2 scholastic system --- with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as their high-school electives ---- cadets of the INA subject themselves to the academic rigours of a carefully-structured syllabus, spread over a four-year period. Successful cadets are awarded a Bachelor of Technology degree either in 'Electronics-and-Communications', or in 'Mechanical Engineering'. The stringency of this 'B.Tech.' programme is over and above the demands of a parallel syllabus that involves training in a number of disciplines and subjects relevant to the Indian Navy and its leadership. We therefore, look upon our cadets as gentlemen/ladies extraordinaire.

The Admirals' Cup Regatta was instituted in 2010 under the burgee of the Indian Naval Sailing Association as a competitive sailing event, in a fleet racing format for Officer trainees of navies of friendly foreign countries. The Admiral Cup is conducted at the Ettikulam Bay i.a.w. dates approved by IHQ MoD (Navy) each year and is competed in the Laser (Radial) class of boats. The last Admiral's Cup was conducted from 04 – 10 Dec 22. A total of 21 countries participated in the event. Admirals' Cup 2023 is scheduled from 03 – 09 Dec 23 at INA with participation of 20 countries.
