

**ADVANCE PROCUREMENT NOTICE**  
**TENDER FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF CONSULTANT**  
**FOR DESIGN AND SUPERVISION OF NAVAL AIR STATION**  
**AS PART OF SEABIRD PHASE IIA AT NAVAL BASE KARWAR**

Director General, Project Seabird, IHQ-MoD (Navy) (hereafter referred to the “Employer”) intends to invite tenders for Appointment of a Consultant for the design and supervision of Naval Air Station as part of Seabird Phase IIA at Naval Base Karwar. For this purpose, tender documents are being prepared by the Project Management Consultant, already appointed by the Employer, and the tender documents shall be ready before the end of year 2017.

Brief details of the Naval Air Station to be constructed as well as the scope of the Consultancy Services are as follows:

**Naval Air Station**

Development of Naval Air Station (NAS) will involve construction of a fully operational and capable airfield with associated infrastructure and a wide range of facilities which support the air operations.

The Naval Air Station, Karwar, is required to be provided with a main runway, a cross runway, and maintenance, logistics and administrative facilities to support the operations of the following types of military aircraft:

- (a) Dornier 228/ Embraer type MR aircraft.
- (b) Transit operation by the Indian Air Force and Indian Army Aircraft.
- (c) Helicopters (Sea King, Chetak, Kamov 31, and other new types of helicopters that may be acquired by Indian Navy in the future, approximate total: 40 numbers).
- (d) Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV)

The total area of the site, where the naval Air Station is to be constructed, is approximately 1,328 acres. The site is marginally undulated with high terrain on south east side of the site.

**Scope of Consultancy Services:**

The appointed consultant shall be required to update the existing master plan, already got developed by the Employer, carry out the detailed design of the works required for the construction of the NAS, prepare tender documents for the procurement of contractor(s) for the construction of NAS and supervision of the construction of NAS.

More details on the services to be provided by the consultant shall be provided in the tender document.

Specific tender notice for the appointment of the consultant shall be announced as soon as the tender documents are ready.
